SACRAMENTO PROMISE ZONE

FACT SHEET

The Sacramento Promise Zone initiative is a public-private-nonprofit collaboration led by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency, in partnership with City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, and over 30 partners and supporters.

Benefits of the Promise Zone

- Opportunity to engage Five AmeriCorps VISTA members in your Promise Zone.
- A federal liaison assigned to assist with navigating federal programs.
- Preferences for certain competitive federal programs and technical assistance.
- Promise Zone tax incentives if enacted by Congress.

Goal of the Promise Zones Initiative

To revitalize high-poverty communities across the country by

- creating jobs
- increasing economic activity
- improving educational opportunities
- reducing serious and violent crime
- leveraging private capital
- assisting local leaders in navigating federal programs and cutting through red tape.

PROMISE ZONE 10-YEAR STRATEGY

Accelerate Job Creation

- 1. Invest in occupational skills training that prepares jobseekers for career pathways to middle skilled jobs that ensure self-sufficiency.
- 2. Improve economic growth by addressing economic impediments that prevent business growth in the Promise Zone area.

Economic Development

- 1. Revitalize commercial corridors that offer revitalization opportunities for retail, commercial, and housing.
- 2. Focus resources on key infill and major development projects to create jobs, improve quality of life and build a sustainable local economy.
- 3. Diversify the economy through growth and support of the core business clusters.

Education

- 1. Increase third grade reading proficiency by focusing on early learning programs and proven strategies. Only 37% of third graders are reading at grade level in Sacramento.
- 2. Improve retention rates by increasing basic skills competencies in reading, writing, and math to improve student preparedness for degree, certificate courses, and employment.
- 3. Support and improve college and career readiness programs.

Health

- 1. Increase adoption of local general and specific plans to improve community design that supports healthy lifestyles.
- 2. Increase opportunities for physical activity through shared use agreements between municipalities, school districts and community based organizations by targeting schools in the Promise Zone.
- 3. Implement strategies to translate and integrate known community health interventions to address high blood pressure and high cholesterol for Promise Zone residents.

Sustainable Community Revitalization

- 1. Strengthen community capacity to address gang involvement and create safe neighborhoods, especially for boys and men of color residing in the Promise Zone, utilizing program such as My Brother's Keeper.
- 2. Increase housing types and transit growth to promote livability and connectivity within the Promise Zone.

Statistics

- Total population covered is 127,893 residents
- Poverty rate is 34%
- Unemployment is 19%
- Life expectancy for residents in the Promise Zone is 72 years verses 79 outside the zone
